

Rustic Coaster

Abbreviations

ch – chain
dc – double crochet
hdc – half double crochet
sl – slip stitch
st - stitch

The Pattern

Starting row - Ch 19, hdc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc across.
(18 sts)

All rows – Ch 1, hdc across (no hdc in ch1 at end).

Work for a total of 15 rows.

Edging

First side - Turn piece quarter turn to work along first side edge. DC in edge of 3rd row from hook 8 times, sl 1 in edge of 2nd row from hook. Repeat two more times.

Bottom edging - Turn piece quarter turn to work along bottom edge. DC in 3rd ch from hook 8 times, sl 1 in 3rd ch from hook. Repeat two more times.

Second side - Turn piece quarter turn to work along second side edge. Dc in edge of 3rd row from hook 8 times, sl 1 in edge of 2nd row from hook. Repeat two more times.

Top edging - Turn piece quarter turn to work along top edge. Dc in 3rd st from hook 8 times, sl 1 in 3rd st from hook. Repeat two more times.

Finishing

Draw yarn through and weave in ends. Or, do as I did and just tie the two ends together in the back, and trim! Linen looks really great washed, or steamed well *but* you could just set down your cup of tea without a care.

Finished Measurements

Roughly 4" (10 cm)square

Materials

Valley Yarns 8/2 Wetspun Linen Warp,
or any fingering/lace weight
cotton/linen yarn

US D/3.25mm crochet hook

Gauge

Any.
